Welcome back! As shared via email last week, I received confirmation of my permanent appointment as Principal of Jinibara State School over the recent holiday break. I am very pleased to know that I will continue working with our school in the coming years and am very happy to be working with such a fantastic school community.

Congratulations to Psalms in year 6 for her outstanding achievements in netball. During the school holidays she made the Queensland indoor netball team that will be heading to nationals end of November. She also made the Sunshine Coast Regional netball team which placed 2nd in the State competition. She has also represented Caboolture Netball Association in the representative U12 Gold team which placed 4th. What fantastic achievements!

Classes for 2023: A reminder that the process of formulating class lists for 2023 will begin later in the term. During this time teachers will consider the most appropriate placement for individual students into class groupings. The aim is to construct well balanced classes in which students can work and perform to their full potential. Due consideration is given to the student's academic needs as well as their social and emotional needs when placement is decided. Should your child/ren not be returning to Jinibara SS in 2023, please inform our office as soon as possible. This assists us with planning for staffing and classes next year and also limits the amount of potential class changes required post the Day 8 count if we are given fair warning of anticipated numbers.


