Overview of Learning Areas

The following overview outlines a brief overview of what students will be learning in each key learning area.

Learning Area	Brief Overview
English	Learn how to write a procedure and understand nouns, verbs and noun groups (adjective with a noun).
Mathematics	Money – identify coins and notes, add coins and notes, identify greater or less money amounts. Time – read analogue and digital clocks, o'clock, half-past, quarter past and quarter to. Number Patterns – skip counting by 2's, 5's and 10's, identify the pattern.
Science	Understanding forces of push and pull.
Humanities and Social Sciences	Differences of past and present.
The Arts	Visual art
Health	Zones of Regulation and mindfulness
Physical Education	In this unit, students will demonstrate fundamental movement skills of rolling, balancing and jumping. They will perform gymnastic skills as a continuous movement sequence that incorporates the elements of movement: body awareness, effort (flow) and space awareness.
Dance	Students will identify and make a dance by exploring two-dimensional shapes and three dimensional objects as stimulus. Students will consider and discuss where and why people dance, starting with dances from Australia including dances of Aboriginal and Torres Strait origin.
Music	Students will investigate Musical stories. They will compose a soundscape that tells a story using graphic notation. Students will perform and create rhythmic patterns using known rhythms up to tika-tika and will explore melody on the staff.
Digital Technology	To recognise and explore how digital systems can be used for different purposes.
