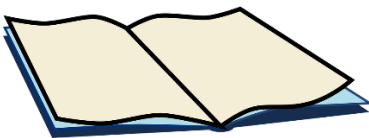
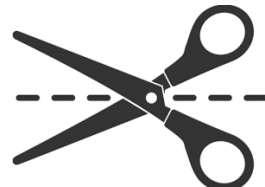

Lesson 3 Vocabulary part 1

All French nouns are either **masculine (m)** or **feminine (f)**.

The word for 'the' is **le (m)** or **la (f)**.

L' is used before nouns starting with a vowel.

'a' or 'an' is **un (m)** or **une (f)**.

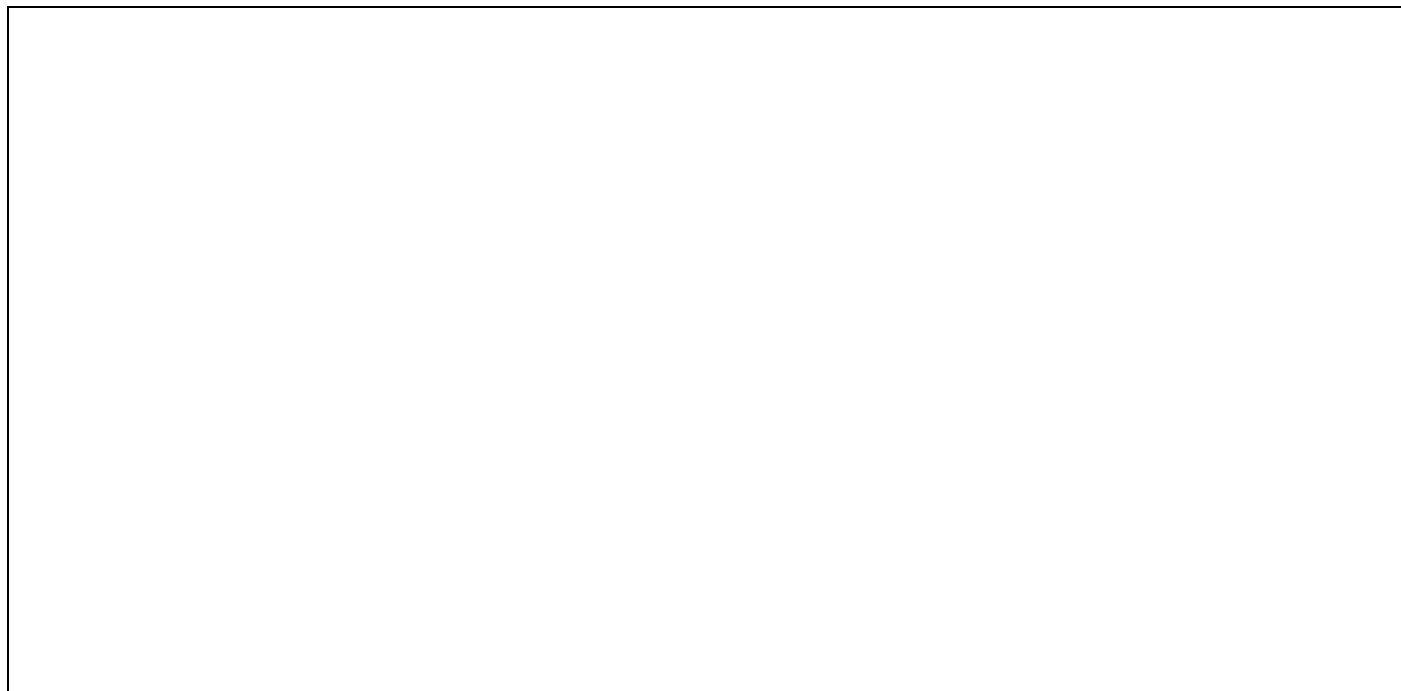
